Challenge:

Create a tally chart showing a variety of people's favourite book.

You could ask people at home or at school for this.

You might want to try reading one of these books if they sound interesting - what did that person like about it?



### Rainbow's Creativity Challenge:

Using coloured pencils or paint, experiment with the different shades you can make when you layer the colours.

Can you create a dark blue? Can you create a deep orange? You could apply this to a drawing or just experiment on a sheet of paper. Which is your favourite shade?
