School Admissions 2021 – 2022

Due to the Covid pandemic, all appeals will be held based upon written submission. This is in line with DfE's School Admissions (England) (Coronavirus) (Appeals Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

For Church of England Voluntary Aided Schools and Academies in the Diocese of Winchester and Diocese of Portsmouth.

National Notification date for on-time applications.	Friday 16 th April 2021.
Notification date for late applicants (whose applications received after 15 January and before the 16 April 2020)	Monday 26 th April 2021.
Deadline date for parents wishing to lodge an appeal. (Returning completed appeal papers to the school.)	Monday 17 th May 2021.
Appeal hearing to be held.	From 7 th June to 16 th July 2021. (Inclusive)
Decision letters to be sent.	Within 5 school days of hearing.

Please note

- i) Appeals lodged after 17th May will be heard during the above dates if possible or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged. In this situation the time frames given above may not be achieved. Appeals lodged on or after 15th June 2021 may not be heard until the autumn term but no more than 30 school days after the appeal was lodged.
- ii) Appellants will receive at least 10 school days' notice of the exact date and location of their appeal hearing.
- iii) Following the lodging of an appeal, additional papers may be submitted to the school until 10 working days before the hearing. Evidence admitted after this date will be considered by the panel but this may lead to an adjournment and significant delays.
