Peter thought he was being very generous and merciful when he suggested seven times might be about right but Jesus said not seven but seventy x seven. Jesus meant that we should always forgive others because we ourselves have been forgiven so much.

In the Lord's prayer it says:

"Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us" Matthew 6:12
