









Spring 1 Choose a Challenge

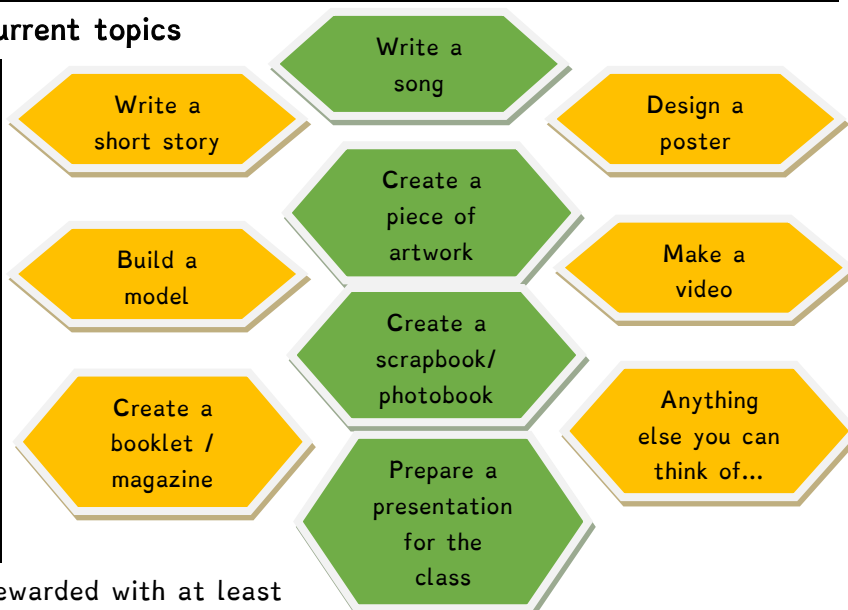

 <p>Gabo's Curiosity Challenge:</p> <p>2HP</p> <p>Gabo is very curious to find out about Viking life. Can you investigate what a Viking children would have got up to? Did they go to school? Did they work? Did boys and girls do the same or different things?</p>	 <p>Domino's Empathy Challenge:</p> <p>2HP</p> <p>Imagine someone you know has not been able to achieve their dream or goal first time. What advice would you give them? Should they give up or should try again? What if they still don't achieve their goal?</p>	 <p>Shelley's Resilience Challenge:</p> <p>2HP</p> <p>Vikings couldn't go to the supermarket to buy food for their meals, they either had to grow or catch it. Using only foods that can be grown (fruits and vegetables) or that can be caught (meat), design your own Viking meal.</p>
 <p>Husky's Collaboration Challenge:</p> <p>2HP</p> <p>Using the Think-it, Link-it grids, practise your times tables with a friend/ family member using the games that go with it. If you no longer have these, come and ask Miss Holyland for them.</p>	 <p>Rainbow's Creativity Challenge:</p> <p>Using our investigations of the Vikings, design your own Viking Longboat. What would you have in your longboat? What shape would it be? What kind of sail would it have? How many Vikings would it need to row it?</p> <p>2HP</p>	 <p>Flexie's Reflection Challenge:</p> <p>Complete one of the other challenges and then use Flexie's Reflection Mirror to consider what went well and what you might change next time.</p> <p>2HP</p>
